Papers to include:

"A little-known, but capable frontier leader": Brigadier General Benjamin Howard and the Defense of the Eighth Military District, 1812-15 – Harold Youmans, J.D., a long-time CAMP member, is a published historian and lecturer on the War of 1812. He has made numerous presentations to groups throughout the U.S. on the War. He is a retired U.S. Army Colonel and the former Editor of the quarterly *Journal of the War of 1812*. Colonel Youmans arguably possesses one of the largest collections of War of 1812 printed materials in private hands.

The Royal Spanish Military Hospital, Saint Augustine (1790-1821) – This is an updated version of the 2016 JAMP article highlighting the advanced medical practices of the Spanish empire in the 18th century by Christine Miller DPM, PhD, University of Florida, College of Medicine-Jacksonville.

Camp Taylor WWI Louisville – Charles Bogart is a former CAMP director who has written many articles for the *Heliogram* and *JAMP*. He has a master's degree in Urban Planning from Ohio State, served in the U.S. Navy 1958-61, and planned CAMP's 1998 conference in Lexington, KY.

Visit site of Long Run Massacre, Floyd Defeat, 1786 death site of Abraham Lincoln (grandfather of president), Simpsonville 1864 Massacre site of 5th USCT Cavalry, tavern site where Clark learned of Lewis death, Kentucky Military History Museum, Civil War Fort Boone, burial site of Daniel Boone, Lt. Presley O'Bannon, Theodore O'Hare, Vice President Johnson, and Henry Clay Jr., Old Capitol Building, Vietnam Memorial
